Families without internet access can currently go to any high school to access free Wi-Fi hotspots. These hotspots are temporary. New outdoor antennas to provide ongoing free Wi-Fi will be installed on all middle and high schools. A request to the County has been made for the purchase of these outdoor antennas for each elementary school.
